The visiting artists series at [Bucks County Playhouse](#) in New Hope presents Brad Zimmerman's "My Son the Waiter: A Jewish Tragedy," beginning March 23 and continuing through April 9. It's the story of one man's struggle to fulfill his dream and 'make it' as a comedic actor in New York, in the format described as "one part standup, one part theatrical, and all parts uproarious."

Zimmerman spent 29 years "temporarily" waiting tables in New York, all the while chasing a career in acting and comedy. His perseverance and hard work eventually paid off, landing him a small part in "The Sopranos" playing Johnny Sack's lawyer and as the opening act for many well-known entertainers including George Carlin, Brad Garrett, Dennis Miller, Julio Iglesias, and Joan Rivers.
