Carole passed along an article from “The Cleveland Scene” newspaper in Ohio about the expansion that indicated the Tokyo location will begin with a temporary exhibit in September. A site for a permanent museum and concert venue will then be found.

According to the article, attendance at the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame has increased since Greg took over as CEO.

Carole now resides in New Hope in Bucks County, but watching recent music performances reminded her of listening to rock music as a teen in McKean County.

She recently enjoyed “Beautiful: the Carole King Musical” in NYC and the Buddy Holly Show at the Bucks County Playhouse in New Hope.
