Best bets: Bucks County Playhouse to host Irish Music Festival Friday and Saturday

The River Drivers open the Irish Music Festival at the Bucks County Playhouse at 8 p.m. Friday

The Bucks County Playhouse at 70 S. Main St. in New Hope celebrates St. Patrick's Day with an **Irish Music Festival** Friday and Saturday. Three Celtic music acts are on the bill, starting with the four-piece River Drivers, who will deliver their mix of traditional Irish tunes and folk music at 8 p.m. Friday. The lineup on Saturday includes the John Byrne band, whose frontman is a Dublin native, at 2 p.m.; and the Galway Girls featuring Celtic Pride at 8 p.m. The festival will also feature a "pop-up" inflatable Irish pub in the Playhouse's courtyard and an Irish whiskey-tasting event from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. Saturday. Individual concerts are \$20 or \$30; weekend pass tickets are \$45 or \$75. Admission to whiskey-tasting is \$35 for single-ticket holders and \$30 for weekend pass holders.
