**What to do:** See affordable theater at the Bucks County Playhouse with [The New World](#) showing through December 2, and [Ebenezer Scrooge's Big Playhouse Christmas Show](#) playing from December 8 through the end of the year. You can also pop into specialty shops like [Farley's Bookshop](#) for rare finds and [Suzie's Hot Shoppe](#) for the spiciest sauces and snacks you'll ever have. There's also a handful of art galleries worth checking out, like [Celt-Iberia Traders](#), [Heart of the Home](#), and [Netherfield Gallery](#). Shoppers will also be happy to spend a couple of hours perusing through an assortment of stores at [Peddler's Village](#).

**Where to eat:** For casual eats with friends, [Bowman's Tavern](#) has something for everyone. For a special occasion with your bae, definitely do the romantic [Lambertville Station](#), which is located just 10 minutes from downtown New Hope on the Jersey side of the Delaware River.

**Where to stay:** Cute B&Bs such as [Fox & Hound](#) and [Olivia's Bridge Street Inn](#) are charming, historic, and downright dreamy places to stay for a night or two.

**How to get there:** Take the [Trans-Bridge](#) bus from Penn Station to New Hope. Get off the bus at Lambertville and walk across the bridge for 10 minutes into New Hope. The whole trip takes roughly two hours.
